

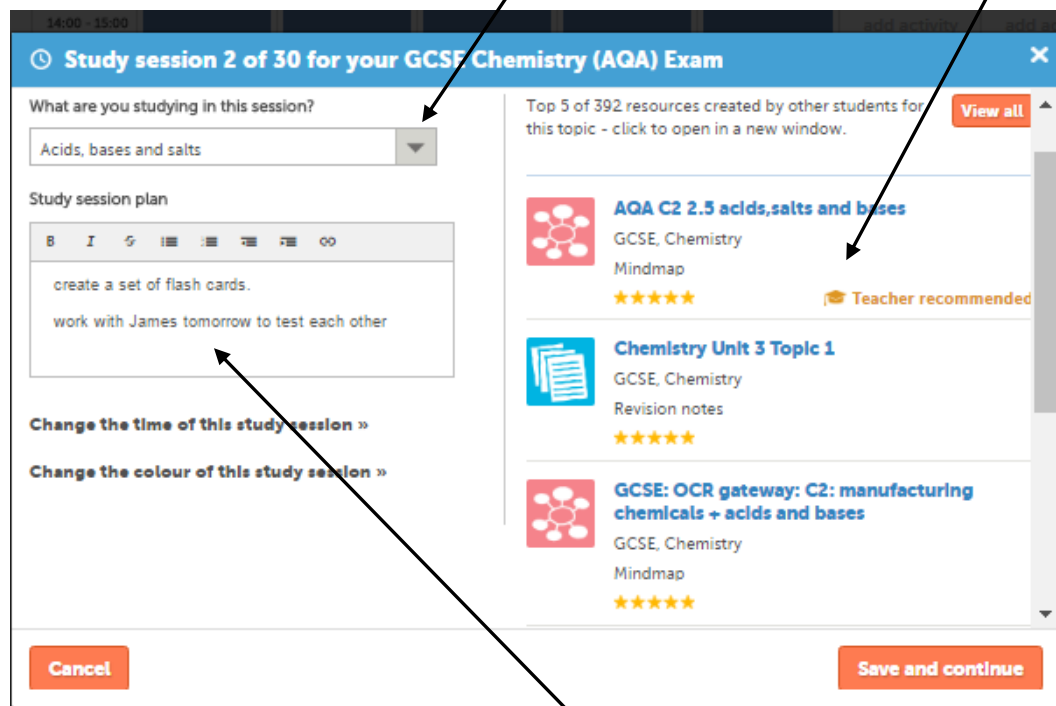
You can drag a subject from on time slot or day to another.

If you have a specific aim then you know when you have achieved it. If you just set a period of time to study the topic then any number of small distractions will get in the way and surprisingly little will be achieved.
