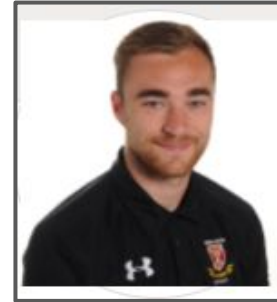

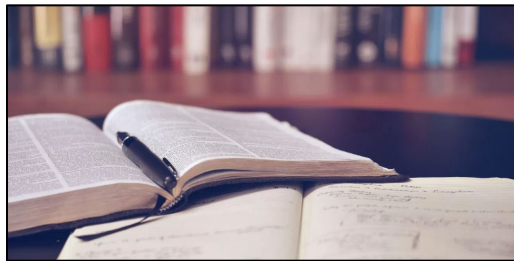

Sixth Form Attendance

- All sixth form students are expected on site for registration each morning at 8.25am.
- Full attendance is expected in all timetabled lessons and timetabled study sessions in the study room (timetabled study is compulsory).





Sixth Form Attendance

- You may have a free period between timetabled lessons/timetabled study sessions. You are allowed to find a free room to work quietly in, use the LRC, go to the lower school canteen or sit in the quad. You are not to be using the courts or astro during lesson time unless for an arranged sports activity.
- You may sign out in the study room and leave the school site at the end of period 2/ break 1 if you have no more lessons/ study periods for the day.

3 Key Areas:

Follows 3 steps:

1. **1 hour compulsory study after school**
2. **Contract/Intervention programme**
3. **Meeting with parent/carer**





Dress Code



Sixth Form students should dress appropriately for a school or office environment, **wearing clothes that give them a professional appearance.** In all cases, branding should be minimal and without large logos.



Standard Sixth Form uniform includes:

Collared shirts, tops or blouses (ties optional)

Suit jackets (optional)

Knitted jumpers (v neck or half zip), smart sweatshirts or smart cardigans (buttoned up only)

Skirts or dresses must be of a smart business wear length. Excessively tight and/or short skirts (bodycon) are not allowed.

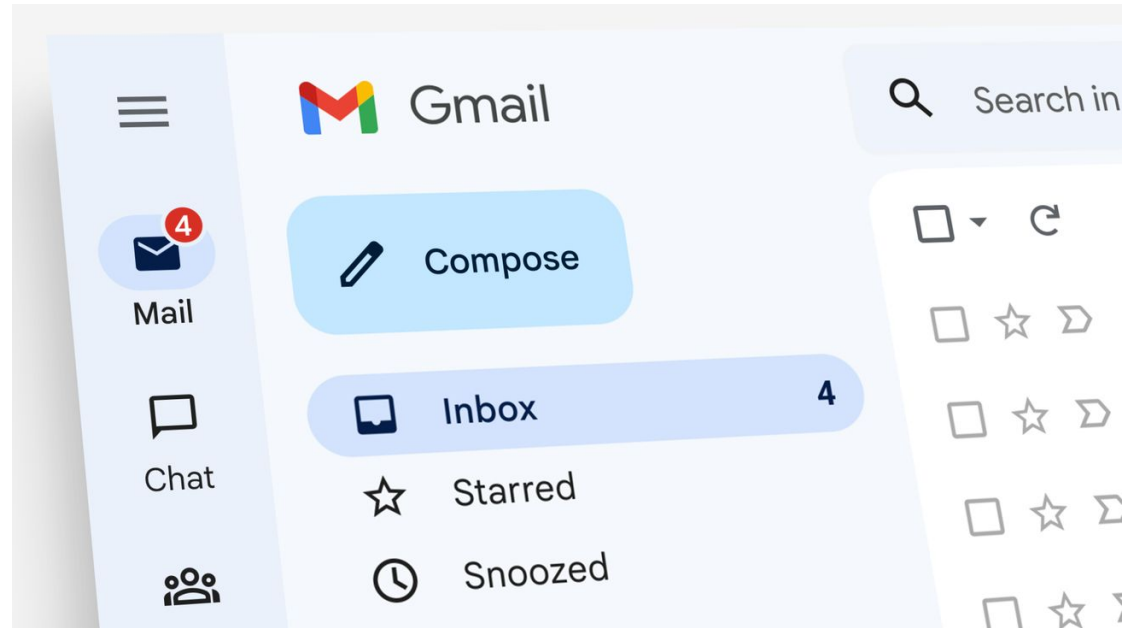
