Our Key Stage 5 Curriculum

At KS5 we are the lead school for the a consortium of 4 schools which means that all students who want to study A Level Music learn here at Vyners.

We currently run A Level Music with the Eduqas exam board which is separated into three parts:

Performance (25%-35%) - Students will perform on their instruments for between 6-12 minutes depending on their option choices.

Composition (25%-35%) - Students will compose two pieces of music which combine to last between 4-10 minutes depending on their option choice.

Appraising (40%) - Students will study the Western Classical Tradition, Musicals and Music of the 20th Century and sit an exam at the end on these.
