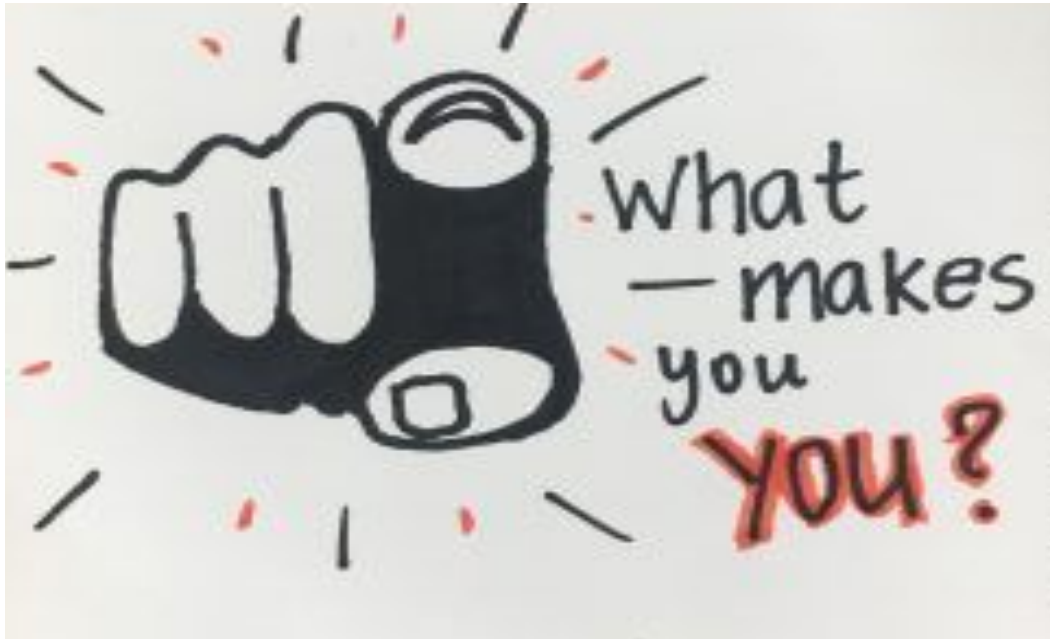

CSS - Compulsory Study Session

3 Key Areas:

1. **Attitude to Learning**
2. **Attendance and Punctuality**
3. **Independent Learning and Self Study**

Follows 3 steps:

1. **1 hour compulsory study after school**
2. **Contract/Intervention programme**
3. **Meeting with parent/carer**





Dress Code

- **A suit jacket must be worn when walking around the school, as well as for assemblies and other formal occasions.**
- **Students should wear a suit or jacket and trousers or skirt, a shirt and tie or blouse / plain top.**
- **Skirts should be of a sensible length. If a jumper is worn then it should be a V neck, and should fit under a jacket.**
- **An official Vyners practical uniform can be worn for relevant subjects. This comprises a Vyners hoodie, plain black tracksuit bottoms and plain black trainers.**
- **A lanyard must be visible at all times when moving around the school.**
- **No hoodies, sweatshirts, jeans or trainers are permitted and we ask that clothes are modest in appearance.**
