

Dress Code

- A suit jacket must be worn when walking around the school, as well as for assemblies and other formal occasions.
- Students should wear a suit or jacket and trousers or skirt, a shirt and tie or blouse / plain top.
- Skirts should be of a sensible length. If a jumper is worn then it should be a V neck, and should fit under a jacket.
- An official Vyners practical uniform can be worn for relevant subjects. This comprises a Vyners hoodie, plain black tracksuit bottoms and plain black trainers.
- A lanyard must be visible at all times when moving around the school.
- No hoodies, sweatshirts, jeans or trainers are permitted and we ask that clothes are modest in appearance.
