

Who Has Got The Answer?

Promotes active listening and whole-class collaboration

How it works

The very basic principle is that pupils get given a number of 'cards' with a question on one side and an answer (to a different question) on the other. Simple as that! Get your gifted and talented students to devise the questions and answers.

One pupil starts with a question, whoever has the answer says it out loud, shows the card to the other players, and then asks the question on the reverse side and so on.

Once the correct answer has been identified a discussion can then take place using the 'ABC' or 'Pause, Pause, Pounce, Bounce' questioning techniques.
