Dear Parents and Students,

Year 12 Geography Fieldwork Trip to the East End of London – 29th January 2018

As part of the A-level Geography course, students will be required to attend two days of fieldwork this term, both in London. The first will be to designated areas in the East End of London. The field work days are beneficial both for the unit on regeneration and also help students develop techniques ready for their own individual investigation later on this year.

Students should meet me at **West Ruislip** Tube Station at 8.30am promptly. They will then travel via Underground to various locations in the East End of London. Students should bring their oyster card with them on the day.

Students need to bring either a packed meal or money to purchase refreshments during the day (there will be plenty of time to purchase food en route and there are excellent facilities in the area.) There will be a lot of walking involved, so students should look at the weather forecast and dress appropriately (comfortable shoes are vital). Worksheets have been constructed in the lesson and all students need to bring with them is their fieldwork booklet, a clipboard or folder with peg (waterproofs for work!!), colour pencils and some spare paper. A digital camera/camera phone/video phone and other fieldwork equipment may be useful according to the data to be collected.

For security reasons, students will be accompanied back to West Ruislip underground station at the end of the day. If, however, you are happy for your child to remain in London after the event and make their own way back (unaccompanied), please indicate this on the reply slip below. Students will not be allowed to remain in London after the event without your consent.

Please can you return the tear off slip enclosed below to indicate that you are aware of the arrangements and ask your son/daughter to return in their next lesson? If you have any questions regarding the fieldwork day please do not hesitate to contact me at school.
