Year 12 Notices:

- **Study skills/ revision strategies** - Advance warning. Mr Mullings will be delivering this session to all year 12 students in the Hall on Monday 20th May, period 5. Full attendance is expected.
- **Year 12 end of year (UCAS) exams** - These will start on the 3rd June over a two week period. A timetable with specific arrangements will be sent out shortly. Year 12 students will be given study leave from school during this two week period, unless told otherwise by individual subject teachers.
- **Attendance** - All Year 12 students must be in school from 8.25 -3.00 pm every day. The study room is open from 8.00- 4.30pm every day.
- **Period 5** - All year 12 students are expected to either be in a lesson, in the study room, or signing in via the finger scanner.

- **Breakspear Road closure:** Please note that Breakspear Road South will be closed from the end of May until the end of June so please consider delays when travelling to exams.
- **Google Form:** A reminder to please complete the google form giving one piece of advice to Y12 students. We have already received some excellent and insightful responses.
- **Study space:** During the exam period, students will be able to revise in the Sixth Form study room or an alternative venue if this is being used for exams.
- **UCAS replying to offers** - A reminder that students should be checking their university offers on UCAS Track and in particular the dates they have to reply by. It is the responsibility of the student to reply to their offers and to be aware of the deadlines to do so as outlined on track.
- **Student finance:** The last day for student finance applications is 31st May 2019.
- **Message from the Network Manager re student collection of data:**

In the student zone of the school website there are instructions for Google Takeout and Google Transfer.
