



Student voice inclusion project, autumn 2025

Purpose

Our Trust's vision is outstanding, inclusive education and our values are aspiration, community and equity. We would like to gather students' images and words to create a Trust-wide mural on inclusion. Students are asked to consider what inclusion means to them in their school context and submit an entry for the mural which can be:

- Written form - this could be a poem, a paragraph, a statement, a call for action
- Image - this could be a photograph, drawing, sketch or painting

Guidance on entries

It is important that entries are authentic in terms of students' own work and therefore must not be taken from the internet or AI generated. Students can submit both a written and an image entry or only one from either category.

Inclusion mural

All entries that are selected for the mural will be awarded points for the Trust's annual VLT cup competition. There may be other awards which will be decided by the central education team whose members will be reviewing all the entries and deciding on those that will be part of the mural.

Dates

The student voice inclusion project will be open for students to submit entries from Wednesday 17th September 2025 to Wednesday 15th October 2025.

Submission of entries

Students can either send entries directly to inclusionproject@vlt.org.uk or to the member of staff in each school responsible for the project.

The mural will be collated and shared with the Trust-wide community during the second half of the autumn term.
