Dear Parents and Carers

Re: heating in the new building

I am writing to provide you with an update regarding the heating systems in the new building at the school. Our heating contractors have informed us that the main parts required to fix the boiler system in the building will be with us today. However, other parts such as the sensors that are also required to support the repair and provide automatic operation will not arrive until later in the week. The contractors have been able to get one of three boilers working manually, which means that it will need resetting at various times throughout the day. However, this, alongside portable electric heaters in each of the classrooms has provided us with a temporary solution and we are confident that the system will be in full working order by the end of the week.

Given that this is the case, we have decided that **all students**, including those in Years 11, 12 and 13, should attend school from Wednesday morning, 7th January, onwards as normal. Students should arrive on site by 8.25am at the latest ready for tutorial and / or assembly.

As highlighted in yesterday's communication, we recommend that all students arrive at school with sufficient clothing for the conditions including outdoor coats (not to be worn in the buildings), plain t-shirts worn under shirts or blouses, school pullovers or similar plain grey v-neck sweaters, etc.

I would again like to thank all parents, carers and students for their support at this time. I will continue to keep all members of the school community updated as the situation progresses.
