Dear Parents and Carers,

Uniform Standards

- No Tech Fleece/Hoodies used as coats. These will be confiscated if caught twice wearing around school.
- Hoop/Dangle earrings are **not** permitted - these will be confiscated and if continuous C4 for deliberate defiance as per our behaviour policy.
- Students with hair/nails will attend a lunch time detention and if continues will escalate to a C4.
- **Flared trousers are also not permitted** and must be straight leg.

Behaviour at break/lunch

Unfortunately, some Year 10 Students have been behaving poorly at break/lunch.
