Subject PIXL Spanish Conference – GCSE Preparation
Tuesday 4 February 2020 - ODEON IMAX Waterloo

We are offering your child the opportunity to attend a GCSE Spanish conference in preparation for the 2020 Spanish GCSE examination at both Higher and Foundation level. The conference is run by the PIXI organization and incorporates advice and key examination strategies from chief examiners.

The conference is not compulsory but we strongly believe that attending this course will be of huge benefit to your child. This interactive and motivational Spanish student conference is designed to equip your child with a range of strategies and techniques to maximise their exam performance at GCSE Spanish.

The GCSE conference takes place on Tuesday 4 February at the IMAX in Waterloo London which means that your child will miss period 4 -5 at school. Staff and pupils will depart promptly from School at 12.00pm to arrive for 1.15pm and aim to return back to Hillingdon Station by 5pm from where the students will be dismissed. The conference begins at 1.30pm. Your child will need to bring money and travelcard for the journey to and from Hillingdon including snacks and drinks. They will also need to wear their school uniform and bring pen and paper for the session.

The cost of the trip is £27.40, funded by voluntary contributions. It will only be possible to run the trip if the level of support from parents is sufficient. If you are experiencing financial hardship and this is likely to prevent your child attending, please contact me. The school has some funds available to facilitate student participation in these circumstances.

Payment should be made via sQuid, our online payment system. **Cash and cheques will no longer be accepted.** Please log onto the system (www.squidcard.com) and select the 'trips/activities purse'. This trip will be clearly visible as **MFL GCSE PIXL Spanish 2020** and must be specifically selected in order to make payment. Please follow the instructions on screen and answer the relevant questions. An emailed receipt will automatically be sent to you by the system once payment is made.
