The details you enter must match exactly to what we have in school. For example, if you use a married name when we have your maiden name on our files, or if you try to enter a different email address, it won't let you in. If you have any problems logging in, please contact parentsevening@vynersschool.org.uk and we will send you the correct details once we confirm who you are.

You can invite a second person with parental responsibility to your appointment. You can give ONE other parent / carer access to join your video appointments in respect of each student linked to you that is involved in the evening. You can grant this access at the time of booking, or later if required. Once you have made your bookings (or when you later login and go to 'My Bookings') click on the 'Invite Parent/Guardian' link at the top of the list of your bookings. If you have already sent an invitation, this link will show as 'Manage Invites' instead.

If you make a Science appointment, please note that you will speak to one Science teacher who will pass on information from all of your child's Science teachers.
