YEAR 12 STUDENT LIFE

At the beginning of the week, all Year 12 students went to the study room during tutorial time to complete a Google document about Post-18 options. The research questions asked us about our future goals and what we intend to do after Sixth Form. This activity helped give us direction, as we created an action plan outlining the next steps we need to take in order to achieve our future aspirations.

On Tuesday in PSHE, we learnt about the effects of drugs such as ketamine and magic mushrooms. We discussed the physical and mental health risks associated with these substances and watched a video about how lifestyle choices can impact our health and wellbeing.

On Wednesday we had an assembly led by Mr Newbey about International Women's Day. The assembly discussed the 2026 theme, "Give to Gain", and Mr Newbey talked about the most influential women in his life. We also learnt about how pay discrimination has changed over time and how women of colour were treated in the past.

On Thursday, we watched a loom video in our tutorials about fire drills and the procedures we should follow to ensure everyone's safety during an emergency.

On Friday during tutorial time, we watched a video explaining how to create and use our account on Student Arbor. The video showed us the different features available on the platform and guided us through the steps needed to log in. This helped to ensure that everyone knows how to access their account and use the features on the system.
