UK University and Apprenticeship Search Trip

On **Thursday 26th March** 152 Year 12 students attended the UK University Search and Apprenticeships Fair at the Emirates Stadium. It was a really successful event with students given the chance to visit over 100 stalls and talk to different universities and companies. It was wonderful to see so many students engaged with members of staff and hope that they came away buzzing with ideas about their next destinations.

Guest Speaker

On **Wednesday 25th March** some Business and Economics students enjoyed a presentation from Amar Nota, the CEO of the Hillingdon Chamber of Commerce. Amar outlined the purpose and activities of the Chamber as a not-for-profit NGO, how it works for the likes of Heathrow Airport and how it attempts to

put businesses together as well as how it is able to provide advice to small businesses about how to develop and expand. Amar, an extremely engaging speaker, also provided lots of timely advice to the students in terms of finding work experience. The students appeared to be really absorbed in what he was saying, as evidenced by the large amount of questions that they asked. This was the latest in a series of talks that have been arranged by the student team of Sean, Rajdeep, Hanif and Lucas. Congratulations to them for showing such initiative!
