**Subject: Year 12 Study Leave March 2020**

Following the recent Year 12 data collection, Year 12 students have been assigned to different study groups in order to best support them and to enable us to put tailored interventions in place where possible. The study group will also determine the study leave that each student is entitled to. Details of the different study groups can be seen below. This means that most students will be allowed to leave school at lunch time if they do not have a P5 lesson.

We have used current progress data to place students into one of four groups: Blue, Green, Amber or Red.

<p><b>BLUE group</b> Study leave period 5 if no lesson</p>	<p>The student is meeting or exceeding their target grade in 3 or more subjects</p>
<p><b>GREEN group</b> Study leave period 5 if no lesson</p>	<p>The student is meeting or exceeding their target grade in 2 subjects and is just below their target grade in their third subject</p>
<p><b>AMBER group</b> Students will be supported to close any gaps in their knowledge in order to make better progress in their subjects that are below target. They may be invited to P5 interventions in order to support this process.</p>	<p>The student is meeting or exceeding their target grade in one subject and is just below their target grade in two subjects OR The student is meeting or exceeding their target grade in two subjects but is a grade or more below target in the third subject</p>
<p><b>RED group</b> Students will be expected to stay in school during P5</p>	<p>The student is not meeting their target grade in any of their subjects</p>


Students will be told which study group they are in on Friday 13 March 2020, in a special assembly, during which they will also receive their progress reports.
