


# Vyners English Department: A Guide to using the Oxford Owl eBook Library



Follow the [eight steps](#) below to access an eBook on Oxford Owl.


**Step One:** Ask a parent or carer to create an account using the 'Join us' button on the 'Oxford Owl for School' section below. They will be sent a confirmation email that contains a link to click on to activate their account.




**Step Two:** Once your parent/ carer has logged in, select the 'Books' category at the top of the screen. In the drop down menu, select the option that says 'eBook Library'.




**Step Three:** Click on the big pink button that says ‘Browse the eBook library’.




**Step Four:** In the **Age** category, select ‘Age 9-11’. Then, you can select from the ‘Fiction’ and ‘Non-fiction’ **Book type** categories. This will bring up your eBook options on the shelves.




**Step Five:** To select a book, click on the cover and it will bring up a box. Click on the **'Read eBook'** link at the bottom of the box. Some of the options on this shelf will have an audiobook only, it is important that you choose a book that you can read along with on the screen. **There is a list of the eBooks that can be read on the screen at the end of this document.**




**Step Six:** You will now be able to see the eBook. To start reading, click on the arrows next to where it says **'Turn'** at the bottom right-hand corner of the screen.



**Step Seven:** The first page of the book will contain some activities that you can do **before reading** and **after reading**. Take a look at these before you turn to the next page.



**Step Eight:** Read the eBook. You can also click '**Audio**' to listen along as you read. We hope you enjoy reading some of these books! Remember to try and complete the '**Before reading**' and '**After reading**' activities, as well as the '**Book quiz**'. You could also write a short review of each book that you read to share with your English teacher in September.
