Dear Parent / Carer

Re: Tuesday 7th July - Transition Day (9am- 2pm): Some minor changes

We are looking forward to welcoming your child at Vyners next **Tuesday 7th July 2026**.

Although we expect some warmer than average temperatures next week, we can confirm that **we are able to host transition day for students** as planned. As a reminder, children need to meet on the Vyners Quad (playground) **by 9.00am, but not before 8.50am**. They will be **released at 2pm**. If children are allowed to make their own way home, please indicate this via this [Google Form](#) if not already done so.

To take into account the warmer than average temperatures, we have taken the following extra steps and ask that you can support these where possible:

- Students should wear their **present primary summer school uniform**, looking smart and ready to learn.
- Students should bring at least two bottles of cold water or a refillable water bottle.
- Students should bring a plain hat for any outdoor time and ensure that suncream is already applied on the day, if required.
- Student activities will be re-roomed to the cooler rooms of the school where possible.
- Students are permitted to bring a small hand-held fan, if desired.

As the school hall tends to get much hotter later in the day, we have made the difficult decision to **cancel** the parent / carer meeting. Instead, we are taking the following steps to ensure you are well supported during the transition period:

- A parent / carer **Cheese and Wine Evening** will take place on **Wednesday 16th September 2026** (late afternoon / early evening). More details about this will follow at the start of next term.
- A presentation for parents will be sent out to you with a few key messages to help you support your child in the run up to the new term. This will be available by the end of the day on Friday 10th July.
