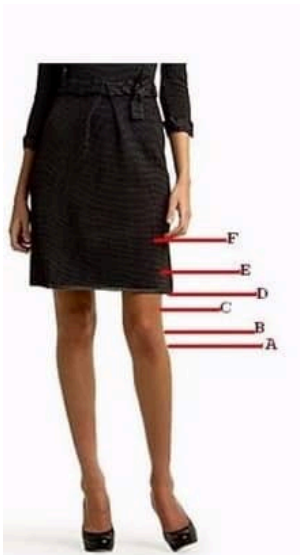
Uniform reminders - skirts and blouses

Some students are wearing skirts that are inappropriate for school wear, particularly without tights, and we will be sending students home to change from next week. Students also need to be wearing a blouse with a collar or a smart t-shirt with a collar.

Skirts should be longer than mid thigh - and should not ride up when walking. If a student is continuously pulling a skirt down when walking around school or upstairs, then it is too short. If a student does not have an appropriate skirt then smart trousers or smart linen trousers (for hotter weather) are acceptable.

Please note that from September onwards students will find the following amendment to the Sixth Form uniform policy giving Year 13 students enough time over the summer to purchase skirts of a suitable length and style if they choose to wear one.

Skirts or dresses must be of a smart business wear length. Excessively tight and/or short skirts (i.e. bodycon) are not allowed.
