Dear Parents and Carers,

We are aware that you may have received a similar communication previously about a slightly different concern. However we do believe it is important that we remain vigilant with information sharing with parents if we receive anything of concern.

We have been informed that there are discussions among some students that there is a planned gathering after school on Friday 17th July on the A40 fields.

At this time, we are unable to verify the accuracy of these reports and cannot confirm whether this information is factual or simply rumour, however we have been informed that there is discussion around alcohol consumption.

In light of this we would encourage all parents and carers to consider the following steps both on Friday and over the summer break:

- be aware of their child's whereabouts and encourage them to avoid this area
- discuss personal safety and responsible decision-making with their child, including the risks associated with consuming alcohol
- remind their child to leave any situation immediately and seek help if they feel unsafe or become aware of any threatening or dangerous behaviour
- contact the police if they become aware of any immediate risk to the safety of young people

We believe it is important to share information that may assist families in keeping children safe.
