Late Detentions

We are pleased to be able to report that we have experienced a significant reduction in the number of students who are late for school in the mornings during this week. This has occurred alongside the implementation of the school's updated punctuality procedures. Whilst we very much appreciate that some parents are forewarning us that their child will be late at specific times, please note that students will still be issued with a late detention if the lateness is related to transport issues. There are some exemptions to late detentions, for example, where a child attends a medical appointment that could not be scheduled outside of school hours. However, in most other instances, students will be required to serve a same day 20 minute detention if they are late at the start of the school day. We would again like to thank you to all parents and carers for their ongoing support with this matter.

Canteen Reminders

Can I remind parents that the school canteen works in the following way:

All students have an automatic daily limit of £6.50. This includes their free school meal (FSM) allowance. Please speak to your son / daughter to make them aware of this allowance. They should not be regularly buying food for their friends as this may mean they themselves run out of money. We have the ability in school to adjust this daily allowance individually per child. Please email kwilliams@vynersschool.org.uk if you would like it adjusting either up or down.

Students in year 7 - 11 will not be able to use a normal contactless card to buy food. Using such a card removes any visibility you have, as parents, about what they have been purchasing. You cannot see a purchase unless it is made via ParentPay.

The FSM allowance is £3.02 per day. This is enough to enable a child to buy a full hot meal and drink at lunchtime. It will not be enough to cover a breaktime snack, and you may wish to send them in with something. The hot meal is the best value item - please make sure your child is aware this is a good choice for them to make.

If your child is FSM eligible, their allowance is spent first. Any purchases over £3.02 will need to be funded by you. Please top up the account in the normal way if you would like your child to have extra purchasing power. Any unspent FSM allowance does not roll forward and disappears from the system at the end of the day

It is the responsibility of parents to make sure there is sufficient funds on parentpay to enable a child to buy food. There is an emergency system of 'pink slips' in place for those occasions where there has been a 'glitch'. Students should not regularly be asking for these slips though and the school will be contacting parents if a student regularly comes to school with no packed lunch or money on their account.
