ADMISSION TO NEW INTAKE APPEALS

If you have not been offered a place at Vyners School, the law entitles you to appeal against that decision to an Independent Appeal Panel. This panel is completely independent of the school and the Local Authority. The appeal hearings are held in Hillingdon.

If you wish to appeal, please download an Appeal Form from the School website on the Admissions page, or telephone 01895 234342 and a form will be sent to you. You should include any evidence or supporting material with your appeal form and you SHOULD give the grounds for your appeal at the time you lodge your appeal form. Your appeal form will not be accepted unless you state the grounds for your appeal. You may appeal for more than one school.

The timetable for appeals is as follows:

Action	Date
Last day for lodging appeal forms for a place in Year 7 to start in September 2021:	Tuesday 20th April 2021 You SHOULD state the reasons for your appeal and supply any documentary evidence at this stage.
Appeals will take place on	Date to be advised in writing.
Invitation letter giving details about your hearing will be sent by the Clerk to the Independent Appeal Panel:	At least 10 school days before the hearing.
Any additional or supporting evidence:	Date to be advised in writing. You are advised that additional paperwork received on the day of the appeal hearing may not be taken into account.
