



What is Live Content?

Live content is when Teachers and Students are online and working together at the same time.

Live content will make up a part of the two week remote learning process.
At least **one lesson** a fortnight will feature live content.

Live Lesson

The whole lesson taught on Google Meets with teachers and students working online with the camera on



Explain

The Teacher will explain the key points in the lesson, take questions and then set independent work.



Q & A Session

The whole class is brought together to discuss an issue. This could happen at any point of a lesson.



Feedback

The Teacher delivers feedback on work that has been completed.



Debate

The teacher chairs a debate in which pupils contribute to a discussion.



Content

The main content of the lesson is read aloud to students or by students and questions are asked.



Low Stakes testing

A quiz in which pupils answer in real-time and have their answers assessed.



Chat Box

Students ask questions through Google Classroom while working and the teacher responds in real-time.



Practical Work

Students complete a practical task under direct supervision from the Teacher.



Subject Variation

Subjects may also decide on their own methods of live content that is unique to them.
