Year 12 Assessments

The Year 12 end of year exams will take place between **24th May to 11th June** and we would like to wish year 12 students all the very best with their end of year examinations. Details have been shared with students in tutorial time through their Google Classrooms and via an assembly.

The assessment topics and timetable are available on the school website <u>here</u>. These exams will take place in the Sixth Form bubble classrooms and students will need to report to room 268 before the start time to register. For exams in the morning, students should arrive on site at 08:30 to register by 08:40 and in the afternoon at 12:30 to register by 12:40.

During the assessment period, students will be on study leave and are not required to attend tutorial time. There will be free rooms available between 08:30 and 16:00 for students who wish to study in school when exams are not scheduled. If a subject does not have an assessment, students will be advised by their teachers of lesson attendance arrangements. This information may be communicated via email or Google classroom.

Wearing of face coverings

Students are no longer required to wear a covering in classrooms or exam settings. Students are permitted to remove face coverings once they are seated and should put them on at the end of the lesson or exam before leaving the classroom. Students and staff will be required to continue to use face coverings in communal areas where social distancing is not possible. This will include areas such as corridors, cafeteria queues and servery areas.

Year 13 Yearbook and Hoodies

The payment has now gone live on sQuid for both the yearbook and the hoodie. Both are priced at £18.50 each. Students ordering a hoodie can confirm colour and size here.

Y13 Grading Information and Ofqual Guidance
