

Headteacher's Update

It's strange to be talking about a football world cup in the middle of November but that is the reality of this year's event in Qatar. Whilst I am aware that several students and staff were keen to watch England's first fixture versus Iran, which takes place on Monday at 1pm, we simply couldn't justify disrupting session 4 and session 5 as well the lunch break for this game. Furthermore, the announcement of the additional bank holiday in May, for the King's Coronation, has meant that schools are under more pressure to protect the curriculum time that is available. From my recollection, this is the only England fixture that is scheduled during the school day; we will obviously be cheering on England (and Wales) throughout the tournament.

I would like to thank Dr Martijn van der Spoel who was in school on Wednesday and Thursday this week working with our students in Year 11 and the Sixth Form, supporting them to prepare for their trial examinations as well as dealing with the pressures of being in an examination year. Main meal pricing in the school canteen

We have just reviewed pricing in the school canteen, particularly of the main meals on offer at break 2 every day. A hot plated main meal costs £2.40. £2.60 buys students a 'meal deal' - the hot meal of the day, plus either a dessert or a drink. Like well known high street retailers, this 'meal deal' is discounted; single items will cost much more if bought separately. The main meal and meal deal both represent excellent value for money and we would encourage parents to speak to their children about their food choices in the canteen. Should students prefer grab and go items, the daily 'blue dot' deal enables them to purchase 4 items for £2.60 - also excellent value.

Tickets for the annual Christmas lunch (7th December 2022) go on sale next week. This is a very jolly event for all, with a full Christmas lunch on offer to students. Both meat and vegetarian dishes are provided on the day, but places must be pre-booked so that Santa knows how many potatoes to peel!
