Headteacher's Update

I would like to start this week's update by wishing all of our families a very happy new year. I hope that the Christmas holiday was a very peaceful and restful one for all and that all families are now able to return to their normal activities in good health. Unfortunately, it does seem that there has been a fair amount of flu, Covid and strep A within the community. Given that this is the case, we have drafted a letter to all families that provides some information and reminders about how to manage these illnesses as well as advice and guidance from the UK Chief Medical Officer about when and when not to send children into school if they are experiencing various levels of illness. On the penultimate day of the autumn term we were delighted to be able to welcome Olivia Marks-Woldman OBE to the school as our guest speaker for our annual awards evening ceremonies. Olivia is the CEO of the Holocaust Memorial Day Trust, which is an organisation that works to ensure that we continue to learn from the horrors of the Nazi holocaust and other genocides that have taken place in Cambodia, Rwanda, Bosnia and Darfur. Earlier on the very same day that Olivia visited us at Vyners, she had also attended the Houses of Parliament and joined the Prime Minister Rishi Sunak and Leader of the Opposition Sir Keir Starmer for the commemorations of the 80th anniversary of the first public announcement by the British Government within the House of the Nazis' attempt to murder Europe's Jewish population. Both Mr Sunak and Sir Keir were in the chamber for a moment of silence led by Sir Lindsay Hoyle, Speaker of the House of Commons.
