

Headteacher's Update

Earlier this week, I shared a letter with parents and carers about the planned industrial action by the National Education Union (NEU). A copy of the letter can be found [here]. We are continuing to analyse the feedback that has been shared by members of the NEU at Vyners so that we can make sound decisions about whether to open on 1st February. As we currently stand, we are hopeful that we will be able to at least partially open, which would mean that the school would potentially be open to specific year groups. I am hopeful that we will be able to fully inform parents and carers of our plans by the middle of next week.

Parents Evening / Options Evening

Thank you to all parents and carers of students in Year 7 for their engagement in the parent's evening last Thursday. We hope that parents found the evening to be informative and welcome any feedback about the session. I would also like to remind parents and carers of students in Years 8 and 9 that the Options Evenings for the respective year groups will take place next week. Both evenings will be hosted by Mr Davey, Assistant Headteacher with the support of the relevant Year Leader. The Year 8 evening takes place on Monday 23rd January starting at 6.00pm in the main hall, whilst the Year 9 event will commence at 6.30pm on Wednesday 25th January.

A level Psychology Visit

On Monday 9th January, I had the pleasure of participating in the A level Psychology visit to the Freud Museum in London. The day felt like a fantastic learning experience for the students as they were able to learn about Sigmund Freud and the psychodynamic approach from a practising therapist, whilst also exploring the house that Freud lived in during the final year of his life after fleeing Austria in 1938 to escape Nazi persecution. Although Freud only

lived in the Hampstead home for about a year his family remained there for some time. This included his daughter, Anna Freud, who became one of the world's leading child psychologists, and his grandson, Lucian Freud, the famous British painter.

Student Toilets

Some of our student toilets have been below the standard that we would expect recently due to a number of factors including some deliberate damage and general wear and tear. I have spoken to students about this in assemblies across the last two weeks and offered an apology. Whilst a number of measures have been put in place to improve standards in the short term, I am pleased to be able to share with families that we have secured approximately £60,000 of funding to upgrade our toilets this year and we are willing to add to this amount from our capital revenue to ensure that all of our facilities are at an exceptional standard by the summer term at the latest.

Careers Week

This week has been Year 11 Careers Week, with students attending a number of talks, workshops, a careers and subject fair and having a mock interview with a local employer. This is designed to support Year 11 students in making decisions regarding next steps, whether they are planning to return to Vyners in the Sixth Form, apply for an apprenticeship or study elsewhere.
