UCAS Predictions

Students received their UCAS predictions straight to their email inbox this morning. We have issued these earlier than the upcoming progress checks to allow students to digest them over half term and use them to inform their UCAS applications. UCAS grades are the most optimistic and holistic prediction for the student, based on all available information. These will be sent to universities as part of the UCAS application process. These grades are usually very optimistic and are a less reliable indicator than the Current Grades and Internal Assessment Grades that you will receive on 4th November. If students have any queries on these grades they can contact their subject teacher in the first instance.

Exams Information
