Please log onto the system (www.squidcard.com) and select the 'trips/activities purse'. This trip will be clearly visible and must be specifically selected in order to make payment. Please follow the instructions on screen. An emailed receipt will automatically be sent to you by the system once payment is made.

It is very important that payment is made before the stated deadline. The school does not have funds available to meet the cost of late contributions. Regretfully, a failure to pay promptly may result in your son or daughter being removed from the trip.


The trip is limited to 120 Year 7 students + 37 GCSE Music students, and places will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Please reserve your place early to avoid disappointment.

Vyners School has detailed procedures in place for ensuring that trips are well planned and that the health, welfare and safety of students is protected. A careful and written risk assessment has been prepared for this trip and adequate student supervision and insurance arrangements will be put in place.
