Uniform Reminder

Formal Uniform

All Sixth Form students should wear **business**/ **formal clothing** when attending school and school functions, unless participating in a practical lesson. If a jumper is worn then it should be a V neck, also in a plain colour which can be worn beneath a jacket.

Sweatshirts, hoodies, denim, Ugg boots or trainers are not permitted.

Practical Uniform

Practical uniform consists of a plain black tracksuit or Vyners' PE kit. At all other times, students must wear a suit or a jacket with trousers/ skirt, a shirt and tie or blouse/ plain top. Skirt lengths have to be of a modest length and **no bodycon fabrics are permitted**.

Safeguarding and Lanyards

Lanyards must be visible at all times when walking around school and in all lessons unless a practical lesson warrants removal. This is part of our safeguarding protocol as a school.

Leaving school premises

Please be aware that Year 12 students may only leave school at lunchtime if they have no further lessons and must always sign out from the study room. Failure to do so will result in a Sixth Form sanction. Year 13 students are permitted to leave school after Period 2 if all lessons are complete for the day and must also sign out when leaving school. This is important to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the students and for safeguarding purposes.
