Progress Checks

Your child has received a copy of their latest progress report today. This report will be available to view on EduLink from tomorrow morning.

If you have not logged onto EduLink previously, please see the attached document which provides instructions on how to do so. Please note that the email address you use must be the one that is registered with the school and that you must be listed as a Priority 1 or Priority 2 contact for that student.

Also attached to this email is the accompanying letter to go with the progress report.

Please note that any subject specific queries need to go directly to your child's subject teacher. You can contact any teacher by clicking on the 'Email a member of staff' link on the Vyners school website.

The students completed a self reflection task today during tutorial on areas they think they have performed well in and areas they would like to focus on improving, setting themselves a target for the next progress check. I would kindly ask that you sit down with your son/daughter to talk through their progress check.

Myself and Miss MacManus have sat down with a small proportion of students today to check in with them regarding progress or attitude to learning. This was a chance for them to be able to verbalise how they feel they are getting on with the subjects they have received any 'red' in.
