Careers Week and Next Steps:

We will be having our Careers and Next Steps week, beginning this **Monday 15th January.** This is an exciting opportunity for Year 11 to get guidance about what is ahead. We will be having talks about career journeys, workshops on career options and interview skills, as well as information about sixth form and apprenticeships. On **Wednesday 17th January**, the day will focus on mock interviews, where all of Year 11 will have a 1:1 practice interview with an external individual and receive feedback. For this, we are encouraging students to wear smart, interview wear for the day. If students forget, or have no business apparel, then they can simply wear their school uniform. Also running this day, is a **virtual parental workshop** via Google Meet which will run from **15:10-16:10**. This will provide clarity of options such as apprenticeships, vocational options and T Levels. To access this workshop, please use the link <u>here</u>.

As part of our Next Steps programme, all of Year 11 will also be having a 1:1 meeting with a member of our Senior Leadership Team. These will take place the **week commencing Monday 29th January.** The purpose of this is to discuss their next step in light of their trial exam results, whether this is Vyners or another sixth form, college or apprenticeship.

To ensure that all students have guidance before making their final decisions, the **Vyners Sixth Form deadline has been extended to Monday 19th February**. All information regarding the application process can be found on the Vyners website <u>here</u>. Please note that students will need to be logged in to their school email account to complete this. If students have already submitted a form, but on reflection have changed their mind, they need to simply submit the form again. There is no need to do this until after their 1:1 meeting. Please note that no decisions are final until results day.

Trial Exam Results Assembly:

On Friday 26th January, students will be having a results assembly during period 5, and will be given their progress checks, with their trial exam grades on. We will be dismissing Year 11 students as soon as the assembly is over. This gives them the opportunity to either discuss their grades with myself, Ms Foster, or Mr Cawley, or make their way home to reflect on their work. We wanted students to have the chance to access their grades first in the style of results day, so have withheld this information in feedback sessions, with students only receiving raw scores. Because of this, we will also be uploading the digitalised version, as well as an explanation as to what the grades mean on Saturday 27th January via Edulink.

Year 11 Parents Evening:

Year 11 Parents Evening will be **Thursday 1st February.** Attendance is imperative, especially as students will be told what they need to do between now and the real GCSEs in order to improve their grades.

Upcoming Spring Assessments:

The next period of spring assessments will be the week commencing **Monday 19th February,** and the week commencing **Monday 26th February.** Students will be informed about this nearer the time, and their subject teachers will communicate with them what they need to revise prior.

Dr Martijn Van Der Spoel:

Dr Van Der Spoel will again be joining us on **Wednesday 31st January** for intervention within the year group. We are targeting students based on their current attainment and engagement with learning.
