

Work Experience

Advance warning that year 12 students have the opportunity to organise their own work experience for the last week of the Summer term, week beginning **Monday 15th July**.

Once work experience has been secured, we ask that this Google Form is completed.

Once we have employer details we will be in contact with them to ask for details of the placement and confirmation of insurance details. We need to do this well in advance to ensure students have valuable and appropriate placements.

Students applying to university courses next year which require work experience, such as teaching, medicine, some law courses etc, should look at securing opportunities for placements now.

<u>Unifrog – The Complete Destinations Platform</u>

Students should now be actively using Unifrog as a starting tool for all sorts of research when considering their post 18 destinations. The specific feature of unifrog for Year 12 students include:

- Exploring Pathways personality quizzes, career and subject profiles, MOOCs and webinars
- Recording self-reflection about extracurricular activities and key employability skills
- Opportunities search tools showing live vacancies/courses/placements for apprenticeships, universities (in the UK and abroad), FE, virtual work experience and much more
- Applications tools to help students build applications for a range of pathways (e.g., CVs, Personal Statements, Common App Essays

YEAR 13 NOTICES

Thank you to all of our students for completing and sending applications over the past few months. A total of 100 applications have headed off to universities countrywide as of the end of today - from as close as Brunel to as far away as Aberdeen.

Thank you to parents for your support with this process. We would also like to thank subject teachers and tutors for writing such glowing references and for their support in checking numerous drafts of personal statements. Thank you also to Mrs Lane, Mrs Harvey and Mrs Coyle for their support in meeting with all students individually and sending their final applications. We are looking forward to seeing some very favourable offers as they start to trickle through over the next few months.

It's worth noting that some offers come through very quickly, others will take at least until the end of March/start of April to make decisions. If you have any questions or queries on the process/applications please do not hesitate to contact me or use the useful UCAS links below for further information.

If students are still sitting on the fence with regard to applying, they have until this **Wednesday 31st January** to submit an application for equal consideration. Students can still apply beyond this date, but their application will not be part of the course equal consideration.

Destinations - non University

Students who have not applied to university will be invited to a next steps meeting with Mrs Lane and Mrs Coyle after half term.

Accepting and Declining Offers on UCAS

Students will start seeing offers coming through now on UCAS if they have sent their applications. If a student receives their last decision on or before 16 May 2024, the reply date is 6 June 2024 (except if you're using Extra to find a place). If they receive their last decision on or before 17 July 2024, the reply date is 24 July 2024 (including Extra choices).

Students do NOT need to make a firm or insurance choice until the deadline of 8th June meaning they have time to consider their options.

There are three different replies students will make on receiving all offers:

- **Firm acceptance** this is your first choice.
- **Insurance acceptance** the back-up choice to a conditional firm acceptance.
- Decline you'll need to decline any other offers you get.
