



Summer exams

Students received a paper copy of their statement of entry for the summer exams during tutorial time this morning. This document outlines which exam the student will be sitting, when the exam is and which tier. Students must look over this document carefully checking that the exams are correct, the tier is correct and that they are studying that subject. Any student who thinks they are entered for anything incorrectly must go to the exam office on **Monday 15th April** and those with exam clash dates should email the exams office at <u>exams@vynersschool.org.uk</u>. The final Summer exam timetable has already been published on the year 13 Google classroom and is available to view on the school website <u>here</u>

Progress checks

Final progress check reports were issued during tutorial time on Wednesday. This report will now be available to view on EduLink. If you have not logged onto EduLink previously, please see the document attached to the email sent home which provides instructions on how to do so.

Any subject specific queries need to go directly to your son/daughter's subject teacher. You can contact any teacher by clicking on the 'Email a member of staff' link on the Vyners school website.

Study leave

The last day of lessons will be on **Friday 10th May**, where students are invited to come to school wearing their year 11 uniform (from Vyners or another school). followed by a leavers' assembly on **Monday 13th May**. They will then start study leave, but will be required to attend one or two compulsory revision lessons with their subject teacher before the half term break, particularly for those subjects that don't have their first exam until after half term. We have found that this has worked really well in the past to prepare students for their exams through focused revision which in turn motivates and supports students. Details of these sessions will be shared via email with students and parents at the start of the Summer Term.

Students may continue to use the study room and canteen spaces during their study leave, as long as they sign in and out of school and wear Sixth Form standards of dress.

Prom

Over 80 Prom tickets have been sold already, so it promises to be a lovely occasion to mark the final year of school. Tickets will be available to purchase until 9th May, but it would be great to have final numbers as soon as possible so that we can finalise details and not have to chase nearer the date.
