Year 11 Plan for the Last Four Weeks of Term:

Many of you have been asking for clarification in terms of study leave. The written exam period begins on **Wednesday 8th May**, so students do have just over two weeks of exams in full time education. The idea of this is to ensure that we can support them and their wellbeing, ensure that they understand the logistics of the exams, and so they can seek their subject teachers for support and advice.

To ensure that students make the most of their time with us during exam season, please find attached the Year 11 plan for their last four weeks with us. It includes changes to their usual timetable to incorporate walking talking mocks with subject specialists prior to the exam taking place, and carves out time for students to revise for PM exams during the school day.

Please note, there are also a few days in which we will be dismissing the whole of Year 11 after Period 4. This is to allow independent study at home the night before Core Science exams. These dates in particular, are: **Thursday 09/05/24, Thursday 16/05/24, Tuesday 21/05/24.**

You can also see from this plan, that **the last full day of Year 11 will be Friday 24th May**, which will end with the Leavers Assembly and Celebrations. After May Half-term, students will only be expected to come in for their exams. More information regarding the logistics of these will follow in the coming weeks.

JCQ Regulations:
